

TECHNICAL SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY ADMINISTRATIVE INSTITUTE IN BASRA



About the Institute

- The institute was inaugurated in mid-March of 1973 under the name "The Technical Institute in Basra", in cooperation with UNESCO and the Foundation of Technical Institutes, based on an agreement aimed at graduating advanced mid-level technical staff to meet the needs of governmental and semi-governmental institutions across Iraqi provinces.
- The institute's name was later changed to Institute of Technology, then to Technical Institute in Basra, and finally, in 2001, it was officially named The Technical Administrative Institute in Basra.
- On July 24, 1988, the Higher Health Institute was merged with the institute, allowing it to provide the community with specializations in technological, administrative, and health fields.
 - The institute currently includes 16 academic departments:
 - 8 in technological specializations
 - 3 in administrative specializations
 - 5 in medical specializations
- It is equipped with mechanical workshops, various specialized laboratories, car repair shops, and refrigeration workshops. These facilities aim to train students throughout the academic year by integrating theoretical knowledge with practical experience, preparing them for the job market after graduation.
- The institute also houses the Environmental Pollution Research Unit, which contributes scientific research and organizes scientific lectures, workshops, and seminars in the field of environmental protection and pollution, serving both students and staff.
- •The institute includes a Scientific and Consulting Services Office, which provides scientific consultations to government institutions, in addition to preparing and executing contracts within its fields of specialization.
- •A health center was inaugurated on June 2019 within the institute's premises to offer healthcare services to staff, students, nearby institutional units, as well as the Southern Technical University Presidency.
